The Dwarf Korean Lilac is a small, spreading lilac with reddish purple buds that open to fragrant, pale lilac flowers. Blooms profusely in midseason, typically mid-May, and first flowers at an early age. Keeping the fragrance of the common lilac in a more compact tighter form makes this shrub a popular choice among lilac enthusiasts. (Zones 3 - 7)
