The White Pine is a hardy, fast growing, soft-needed evergreen. It is native to the eastern United States and is well suited to lowa climate and soil. While young, the White Pine is mostly pyramidal. The mature shape is cylindrical and usually flat-topped. These trees work great in windbreaks or as a specimen tree. The innermost needles will shed yearly in the fall. Avoid planting in wet soils. It has an open form but can be used as a windbreak.
