Northern Pin Oak is a faster growing oak than other varieties, but it still retains its hardy characteristics. It has deeply lobed leaves that turn a reddish orange in the fall. It will produce acorns as it matures. The pointed ends on the leaves help to differentiate this oak from other oak varieties.
